Our low camper-to-staff ratio provides tremendous individual attention. Stations, individual instruction, and gym-or-swim are available each day. Many contests are held daily.

Facts:

Location: Mansfield University is located on Route 6 & 15 in the borough of Mansfield, PA. We can easily be reached by Interstate 80 and Interstate 390. Driving time from Williamsport, 40 min.; Corning, 30 min.; Scranton, 2 hrs.; Harrisburg, 2 hrs. 30 min.; Erie, 3 hrs. 30 min.; Philadelphia, 4 hrs.

Housing: Residential campers will stay two to a room in the MU residence halls. Roommate requests are accepted. Those with summer or all-star commitments may leave camp when necessary. Camp counselors/coaches stay overnight on the same floors as the campers, providing constant supervision. Shower and restroom facilities are conveniently located on each floor.

Dining: Campers will enjoy nutritious meals daily in Manser Dining Hall on campus. A choice of at least two hot entrees is provided for every lunch and dinner, as well as a complete soup & salad bar. An ice cream bar is also available. The menu is all-you-can-eat.

Facilities: The instruction and recreational activities for the 5-day individual camp will primarily take place in the awesome Rod C. Kelchner Fitness Center. This state-of-the-art facility is conveniently located near the residence and dining halls. All other camp offerings will take place in Decker Gymnasium, home of the Mountaineers, on campus. This is a newly renovated college game facility.

What to bring to camp? Sneakers, plenty of socks, t-shirts, shorts, towels, fan, sheets, pillow, blanket, toiletries, spending money, swimming suit, water bottle, casual (sandals) shoes, whistle lanyard (for safekeeping of dorm key), alarm clock/radio, and snacks.
