CAMP DIRECTOR Tim Dempsey

Tim was hired in August of 2001 to head and build the new women's soccer program at Mansfield University after 12 very successful seasons at NAIA power, Green Mountain College, Vermont. In just four years, the 2005 Mountaineers produced the first winning record in school history at 8-7-3 and are positioning themselves to make a run at the play-offs in the years ahead.

While at Green Mountain, his teams won 11 conference, four district, and four regional championships as well as playing in three NAIA National Championship Tournaments. Dempsey's teams were consistently ranked in the Top 25 in the country with his undefeated 2000 squad ascending to #6 in the country.

As a collegiate player, Dempsey was an NCAA Division III All-American and captained the Glassboro State College (Rowan University) soccer team to an NCAA Division III National Championship in 1981.

One of Dempsey's biggest assets as camp director is his love of teaching the game and the fun he has while working with young children. He has been working camps and clinics for over 20 years from Vermont to Tennessee. He is highly respected by his peers for his knowledge of the game and his ability to teach the fundamentals of the game of soccer. He has coached numerous All-Conference, All-Region, and All-American players and holds a USSF "C" National Coaching License
